History of NTAC



- In June of 2006, Network Advisory Group (NAG) created
- Charged with providing recommendations on a technical advisory structure that would advise the design, deployment and operation of the new Internet2 Network
- In August of 2006, NAG produced report recommending that the Network Technical Advisory Committee (NTAC) be created

NTAC Goals



- Provide the best technical **advice** to Internet2 network staff by bringing as much expertise from the community as possible
- Maximize the opportunity for **community participation**
- Provide the greatest possible transparency into its processes and decisions

NTAC Members



- Open to those associated with an Internet2 University Member or Research and Education Network Member
- Members should be committed to regular and active participation in helping the NTAC achieve its goals
- Community-elected Chair
- Creating Vice Chair position

NTAC Meetings



- Monthly calls of entire NTAC
- Reports from working groups, Internet2, AOAC, ARIN
- Face-to-face meetings at Internet2 meetings, typically member meetings
- Other working group calls
- No scheduled NTAC meeting in College Station, TX
