Legacy Registration Services Agreement (Legacy RSA)



- Resources issued before December 1997 are considered “legacy”
- Created to allow formal agreement between legacy holders and ARIN
- It is NOT required
- ARIN WILL continue to provide services without a signed Legacy RSA, minus any policy changes passed by the community

* 213 signed as of December 31, 2008

4-Byte AS Numbers

- 2007 & 2008
 - 2-byte default
 - 4-byte optional
- 2009
 - 4-byte default
 - 2-byte optional
- 2010
 - 4-byte only
 - ARIN policy states only 4-byte AS Numbers to be assigned
