Internet2 FiberCo® supports the Internet2 community's goals of developing and deploying advanced network applications and technologies, and complements existing Internet2 network infrastructure, by providing a means for regional initiatives to acquire fiber optic network assets.

FiberCo Service Offerings

FiberCo was established as a means of acquiring, holding, and distributing dark fiber network assets. Through its agreement with Level 3 Communications, FiberCo offers intercity and metro dark fiber and colocation services at competitive rates to the Internet2 community. Any research and education member of Internet2 may work through Internet2 FiberCo to acquire dark fiber. Costs depend on the location and length of the dark fiber required.

- Nearly 13,000 route miles of intercity dark fiber within the U.S.
- Metro dark fiber assets in select U.S. cities
- Complements the existing Internet2 Network infrastructure
- Facilitates regional optical networking initiatives around the country
