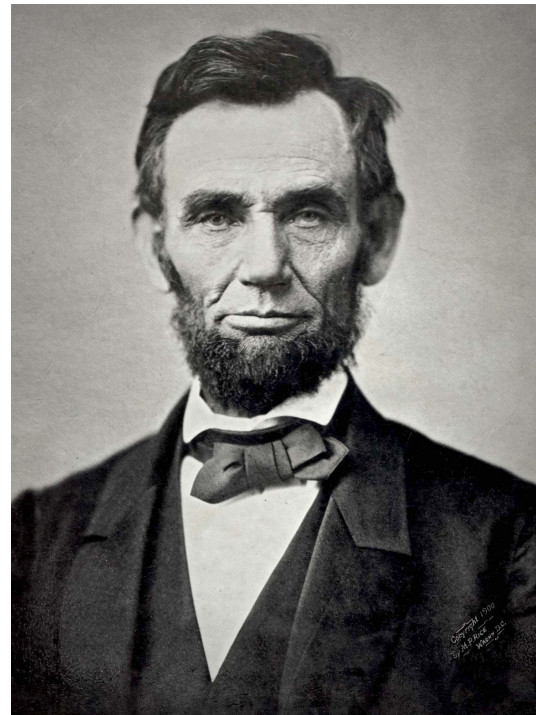


## Abraham Lincoln: "Naturally Anti-Slavery"
