During the Park Ranger led 50-minute program, students in grades 6-12 will learn about the events of September 11, 2001, the story of Flight 93's passengers and crew members, and how their actions that fateful morning changed world history. We will explore why and how we honor others through the interpretation of the national memorial's design and exhibits. Students will explore the Flight 93 memorial landscape as a place of healing for a grateful nation.

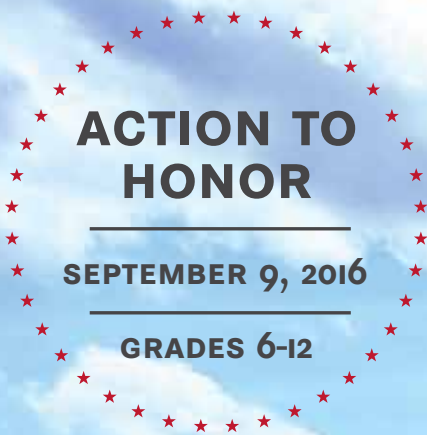
