Active ACAMP AIs

1. Determine next steps for promotion of open source IdM products
2. Write developers guide to federating applications
3. Revise the InCommon Silver IAP
4. Identify and promulgate tools for risk assessment and entropy calculation
5. Affirm direction for Kuali Identity Management
6. Increase Kuali participation in EDUCAUSE IdM WG
7. Develop capabilities in Grouper for federated group management similar to CManage
8. Document and promulgate best practice for syncing google groups from campus groups
9. Document and promulgate best practice for sharing google docs with federated users
10. IAM governance best practices
11. Case study of UNC-Chapel Hill's SPML implementation
12. Determine how federated provisioning should work and participate in SPML standards work to support it
13. Assess various policy engines using MACE-Paccman benchmark use cases
14. Define a standard API for groups
