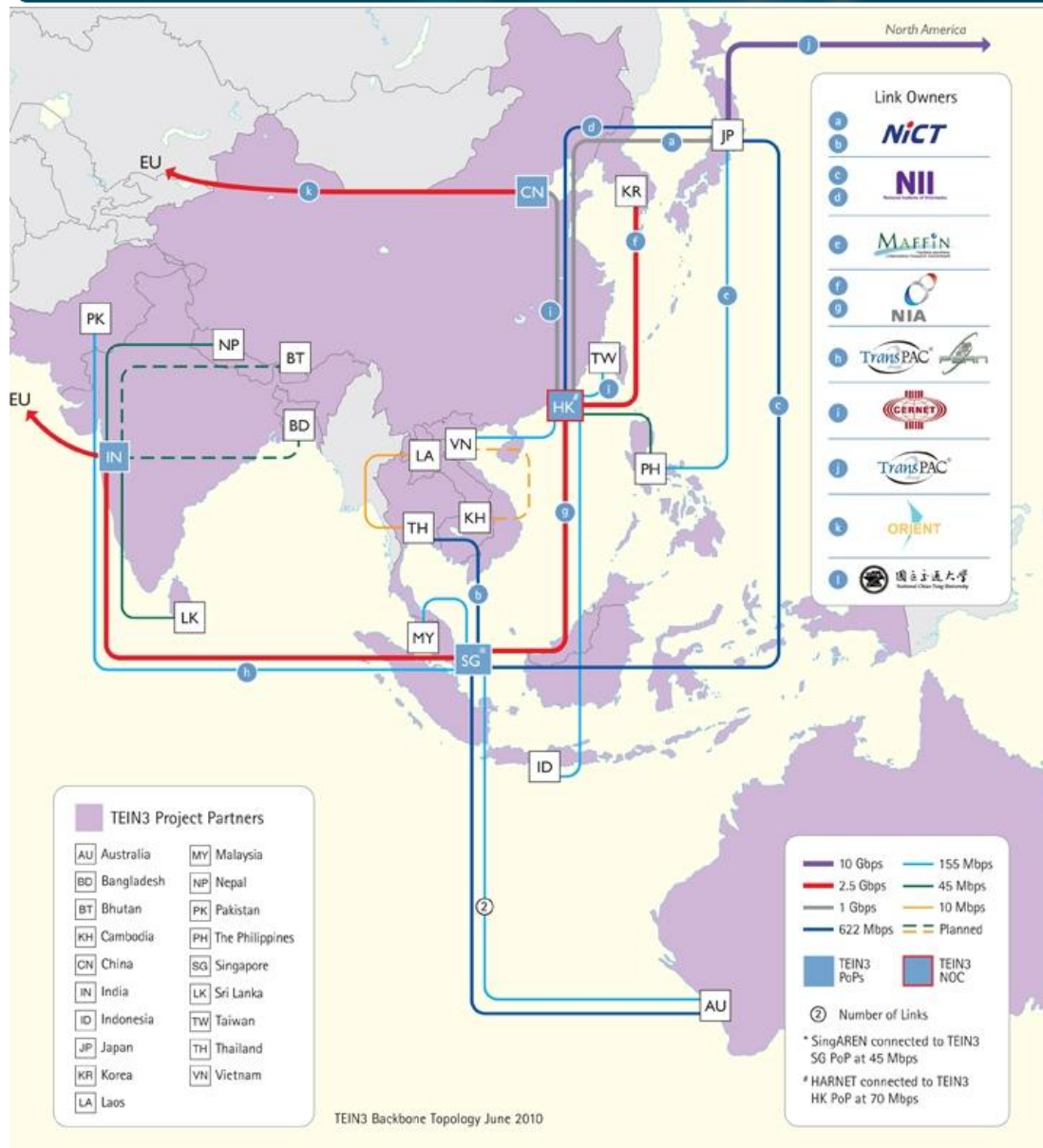

Asia-Pacific (I): TEIN3



- DANTE-led TEIN3 Project runs until September 2012.
- Beneficiary partners (BD, BT, KH, IN, ID, LA, MY, NP, PK, PH, LK, TH, VN)
- Non-beneficiary partners (AU, CN, JP, KR, SG,)
- 45M+ connected users
- 4 network hubs
- 21.4M Euro EC funding TEIN2/3 + significant contributions from non-beneficiary partners and TransPAC2

Asia-Pacific (II): TEIN4



- The Korean not-for-profit TEIN* Cooperation Center is the contracting party with the EC for TEIN4
- TEIN* will manage TEIN4; DANTE remains a partner and will maintain an active role in the project
- TEIN4 begins in January 2012; TEIN3 and TEIN4 will overlap for nine months, allowing operational responsibility to be transferred to TEIN* Cooperation Center
- Discussions underway to agree on Partners
- Procurement notice to be announced in the Autumn of 2011.



Asia-Pacific (III): ORIENTplus



- Successful EC FP7 funding bid by 'ORIENTplus' project
 - Total budget = €4 million
- Project runs Jan 2011 to Dec 2014, with EC contract from July 2011
- 50:50 China/EU project
 - Chinese partners: CERNET and CSTNET
 - 10 European NREN partners
 - DANTE is project co-ordinator
- 2011 Copenhagen-Beijing connectivity maintained at 2.5 Gbps by CERNET
 - CSTNET tendering for 2012 connectivity
 - DANTE/EU partners will tender for 2013 and 2014 connectivity
 - Plan to upgrade the link once affordable
- ORIENTplus link remains available for use by TEIN3 community
