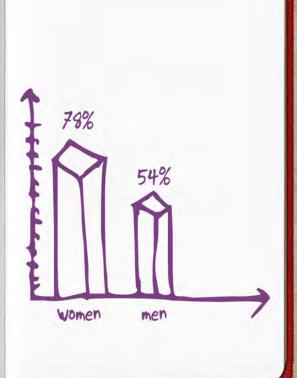
**Imposter** syndrome refers to an internal experience of self-doubt and believing you are not as competent as others perceive you to be.



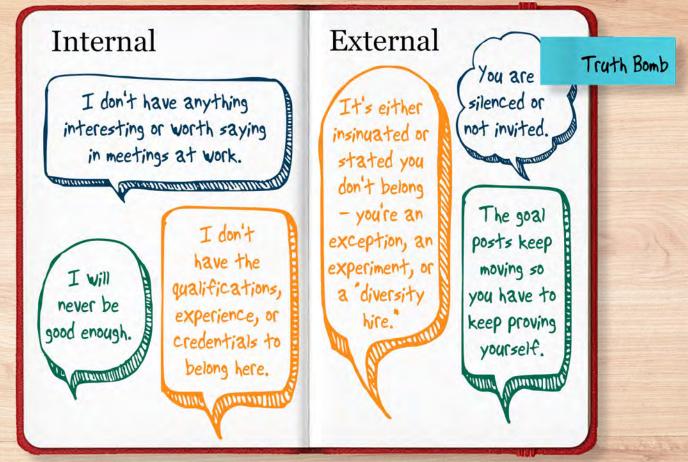
Women are 22% more likely than men to experience imposter syndrome at work.



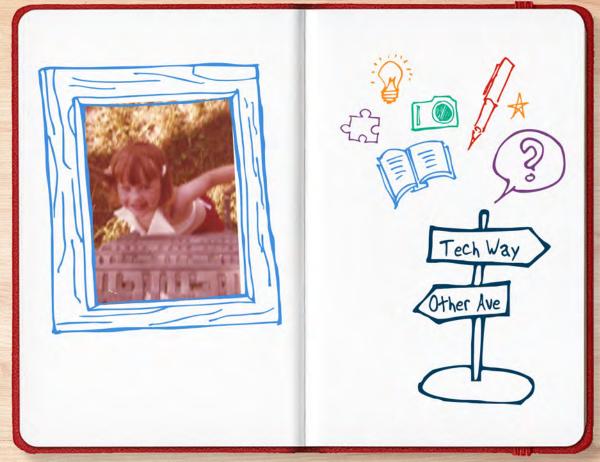
78% of women in tech say they have to work harder to prove their worth. Only 54% of men say the same.





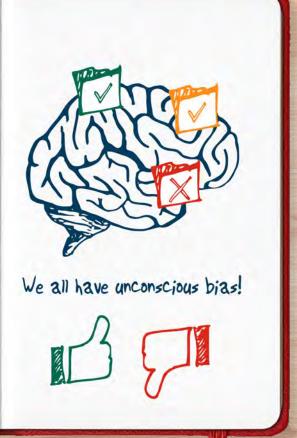








Unconscious bias or implicit bias is instinctively categorizing people and things without being aware of it.

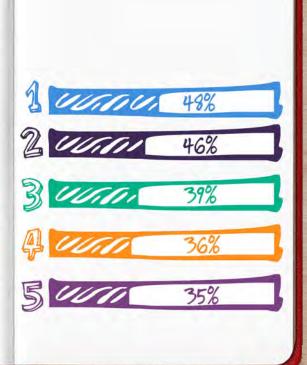






## Top Five Barriers:

- 5. Unequal pay for the same skills





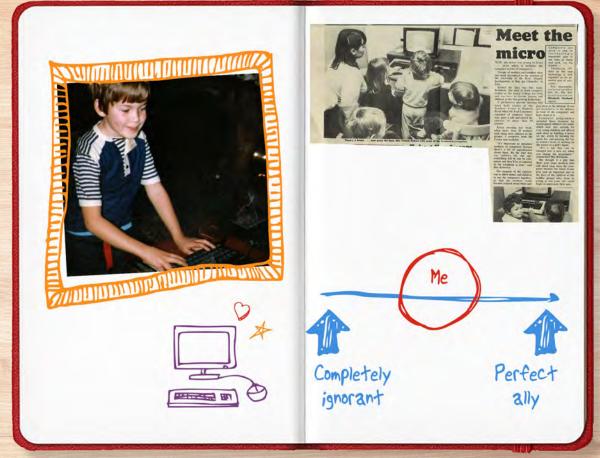
Truth Bomb
